## NEW ARRIVALS



Holly, a 21-year-old Paint, arrived from the Orange County Sheriff's Mounted Unit where she served for 13 years; they consider her one of the better horses they have ever had. Holly trained new officers and excelled at crowd control. Her résumé includes the NBA Finals in Orlando and the Super Bowl in Jacksonville. Holly is only the third mare police horse to be retired at the Retirement Home for Horses (RHH).



Yoshi is a 20-year-old Anglo Arabian who came to us from the Horse Protection Association of Florida (HPAF). Rescued in 1999, HPAF took Yoshi in, got him healthy and adopted him out in 2000. He arrived, in a neglected state, at a Mustang rescue in Plant City three weeks before his arrival at RHH. He was identified by a freeze brand on his neck and was returned to HPAF who asked us to give him the safe and forever home he so deserves.



Benji, a 24-year-old American Saddlebred, arrived from the South Florida SPCA after he was found abandoned on a property.



Sampson is a 20-year-old Arab/Standardbred who was found abandoned in the street and rescued by the South Florida SPCA. He arrived here with Benji and they have become best friends.

Mo-Mo, a 21-year-old Dutch Warmblood, and Lancelot, a 20-year-old Black Percheron, arrived from the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Mounted Patrol Unit after serving 11 and eight years, respectively. Mo-Mo was retired due to an arthritic hind end and Lance due to stifle lameness and caudal heel pain.
