The Alachua Conservation Trust Conservation Stewards Award for 2015



Mary and the late Peter Gregory's love and concern for horses began many years ago when they were a young couple living in England. In 1983, after retiring from the hotel industry, they were able to begin their lifelong dream to provide a better place for horses when they purchased 140 acres in Alachua and created the Retirement Home for Horses. Since then, they have been able to expand the farm to 335 acres and save hundreds of horses from abuse, starvation and neglect. Peter was a founding board member of ACT, and the Gregory's Mill Creek Farm has been protected with a conservation easement that they donated to ACT in 2006. Although Peter passed away in March 2014, Mary and their son Paul continue to carry on the legacy of ensuring that this sanctuary will remain the forever home for these wonderful elder horses. Mary and Peter will be honored for all their work conserving land and water resources over the years in North Central Florida, and for all their efforts to provide lifelong care and love for elderly, abused and neglected horses.
